

JOB DESCRIPTION:

P/T SEASONAL GROUP SWIM INSTRUCTOR

SUMMARY

Group Swim Instructors teach learn-to-swim lessons for infants, toddlers and children of all ages at the Rockville Center pool facility while exceeding customer service expectations.

DISTINGUISHING CHARACTERISTICS:

This class is a direct report to Rockville's Aquatic Manager(s). The pool opens on Memorial Day weekend (Saturday, May 26, 2012) and closes the week after Labor Day (Sunday, September 9, 2012) or shortly thereafter. This is a private, family-oriented rural community pool. It is owned and maintained by its members and governed by the Rockville Center Board composed of center members. We anticipate our membership in the 2012 season will consist of 180-200 families, equating to a total of 700-750 individual members.

APPLICATION DEADLINES:

Applications will be accepted through April 30, 2012.

PAY RANGE:

\$15.00 per hour starting pay. Pay commensurate with experience.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Pre-School, Beginner and Advance Beginner group learn to swim lessons will develop the following skills:

1. Pre-School: 3-5 (potty trained)
 - Gets face wet with instructor
 - Gets face wet unassisted
 - Gets face wet and blows bubbles
 - Hugged underwater dip (hair wet)
 - Pushes from side to instructor
 - Pushes from instructor to side
 - Assisted back float
 - Assisted kicking on back
 - Assisted kickboard skills
 - Jumps to instructor from side
 - Puts face in water to recover object
 - General comfort in water
 - Safety Skills

2. Beginner: Age 4-7 yrs and can perform Pre-School skills
 - Repetitive bubble blowing & breathing
 - Independent kickboard skills
 - Independent kickboard kicking for 1 length (25 yards)
 - Streamline to & from wall unassisted
 - Kicking on back with arms at side
 - Single arm backstroke
 - Both arms backstroke 1 length (25 yards)
 - Deep-water jumps off blocks
 - Retrieval of object 3 feet underwater
 - Safety Skills

3. Advanced Beginner: Age 6 and up and can perform Beginner skills
 - Kicking on side with extended arm

- Single arm catch-up freestyle
- Catch-up freestyle with bilateral breathing
- 25 yard competence in catch-up freestyle
- Rifle drill backstroke
- 50 yard competence in backstroke
- Counting strokes from flags to wall
- Retrieval of object from pool bottom
- Introduction to diving from side
- Introduction to breaststroke
- Safety Skills

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

- Must be kind, enthusiastic, energetic and patient with children.
- Integrity, self-motivation and the ability to work cooperatively with respect for members, guests, coaches and other employees is required.
- Ability to address patrons' questions and concerns in a diplomatic, professional manner is required. Customer Service experience is a plus.
- Knowledge of rules and regulations governing the instruction of group swim lessons at The Rockville Center pool facility is required.
- Must maintain a degree of fitness and strength to meet the demands of the job.
- Knowledge of lifesaving methods and procedures, including Lifesaving, First Aid and CPR, and skill in their application is preferred.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must have previous swim instruction experience.
- Must be 15 years of age or older.
- Must hold a current Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation for Lifeguards (CPR for Lifeguards) or Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation for Professional Rescuers (CPRPro, CPR for the Professional Rescuer) certification. It may not expire during the season.
- Current Lifeguard certification preferred.
- Water Safety Instructor or equivalent certification preferred.
